KEY CONSIDERATIONS



The Bulleen-Templestowe Basketball Club is thrilled to be able to re-open our doors to our community and club family. We ask that you familiarise yourself with the following guidelines to provide a smooth transition to our post COVID-19 policies and requirements.

The following guidelines are developed in conjunction with the Victorian Government, Basketball Victoria, the Manningham Council and the YMCA Manningham with the primary intention of restricting the number of people within stadiums at any one time to reduce the chances of person to person transmission of COVID-19.



PLEASE STAY HOME IF YOU ARE FEELING UNWELL, HAVE ANY COVID-19 SYMPTOMS INCLUDING COUGH, SORE THROAT, FEVER, FATIGUE OR SHORTNESS OF BREATH, OR IN THE LAST 14 DAYS HAVE HAD CLOSE CONTACT WITH A KNOWN OR SUSPECTED CASE OF COVID-19.

ANYONE WHO IS UNWELL OR HAS BEEN IN CONTACT WITH A CONFIRMED CASE OF COVID-19 SHOULD CONTACT A DOCTOR IN ACCORDANCE WITH VICTORIAN HEALTH GUIDELINES.

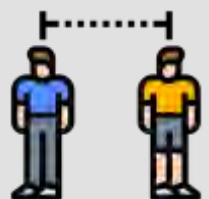

ARRIVE ON TIME LEAVE PROMPTLY.

Players should aim to arrive no earlier than 10 minutes prior the start of their training or game and no later than 5 minutes prior. Each court will have a designated waiting area prior to entering the courts. Participants and officials cannot enter the court area earlier than the designated time. Staff will advise players when they can enter their courts.

BASKETBALLS.



Any basketball brought into a venue will be required to be sanitised upon arrival. BTBC will not loan basketballs to participants with the exception of game balls. Casual shooters and representative players are to bring their own balls to shoot or train with however these balls must be sanitised upon arrival when completing the attendance sign-in and hygiene process.

DOMESTIC PLAYERS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO BRING OWN BASKETBALLS.

BREAKS BETWEEN GAMES & TRAINING SESSIONS.



A small break between games, training sessions and development programs will be required to allow time for participants and officials to depart and arrive without contact. This will also assist staff to ensure all sanitisation requirements are met, prior to the next time slot.



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VENUE INFORMATION



CAPACITY CONTROL.

BTBC staff will maintain strict counting of capacity within the stadium and on each court to ensure that limits are not exceeded.



DESIGNATED ENTRY & EXIT.

BTBC will require all participants, officials and staff to enter through the designated entry where they will be required to sanitise hands, sign-in and be temperature checked before progressing into the venue. After participants and officials have finished their game or activity, staff will guide them to their relevant exit allowing the next group of participants to enter the venue.



CASH HANDLING.

At this stage, BTBC will not be accepting cash payments. Transactions can be made online, EFTPOS or through the TeamPay app for team and game sheets.



OFFICIALS.

Officials will remain in consistent groupings eg. remain on the same court for multiple games or sessions. If any officials become aware that the court is not complying with the guidelines the game will be stopped until the situation can be rectified.



SANITISATION.

Hand sanitiser will be provided upon entry and exit as well as at each score bench. Players and officials will be required to use hand sanitiser at each break, including time-outs and as substitutions enter and exit the game. Players are encouraged to bring their own 100mL hand sanitiser to assist in quick access.



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VENUE INFORMATION



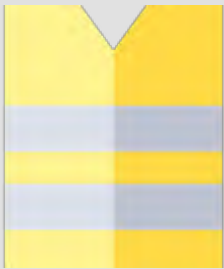
TOWELS & DRINK BOTTLES.



Participants and officials should bring their own towel and drink bottle. Water fountains, the cafe and vending machines are all closed until further notice.

Any drink bottles or towels left at the venue will be disposed off during the sanitisation process at the end of a game or activity.

BIO SAFETY OFFICERS.



All BTBC staff will be trained as Bio Safety Officers and will manage restrictions enforced by the Government, Basketball Victoria, the YMCA and the club. Staff will oversee social distancing, number of participants, management of basketball hygiene and player compliance.

PERSONAL PROTECTION EQUIPMENT.



Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) consisting of disposable gloves and face coverings are available for patrons and staff members that would like to use them.

SMART PHONE CHECK-IN



We are required to collect information from all patrons that enter venues. This information is encrypted on a secure server and is stored for 28 days. The information is not shared with any third parties unless there is a COVID-19 case relating to the club where the information will be shared with the Victorian Government and Basketball Victoria.

Using your smart phone, scan the QR-Code. These codes are located at the venue entry point.



If you don't have a QR-Code Reader, they are available for download from the various 'App Stores' with many free options available.

If you don't have a smart phone, a manual check-in form will be available.

Enter your information including your name, phone number and what part of the venue you will be located.



Once completed, press the **SUBMIT** button at the bottom of the screen.

When completed, a **GREEN** tick will appear on your screen.

Show this tick to a staff member to be marked off, temperature tested and sanitised.
