- Our club has a Child Safe Advisor, who is trained to act on any concerns raised.
- Each year we will speak with our members, staff, volunteers, the children and young people who participate in programs at our Club, and their parents. We will consider and respond to feedback and advice about making our Club as safe as possible.
- We are committed to hearing directly from our children and young people.
