REGISTRATION

- All Registrations are submitted via the PlayHQ system.
- Registration must be completed by the closing date of Friday 22 March 2024.
- The whole Junior Domestic Fee must be paid in full at the time of registration to complete your registration. (Special circumstances for payment plans can be negotiated by contacting the Competitions Manager: compsmanager@bulleenboomers.com.au)
- Please also note there is a Basketball Victoria Licence fee which is a separate annual fee paid to BV. \$29 for players 17 and under and \$43 for 18+, this covers insurance and membership to BV for 12 months. This license covers all competitions so if you have already paid it through Championship or Junior Community League you will not have to pay again unless it falls due before the end of season.
- If wanting to be considered to play up an age group, you must note this on your registration form with reasoning why otherwise you will be placed according to your age. Please note requests will be subject to approval by the Competitions Manager.
- Please note it is not recommended that U09 players play up an age group and will only be approved under **special circumstances**.

GAME DAY: SATURDAY

Earliest Game time: 8:30am Latest Game time: 8:10pm

In general terms, the younger the age group, the earlier in the day games are held.

U9 to U15 are expected to be available for most game times from 8:30am to 4pm.

U17 - U21 age groups are expected to be available for games after 5.40pm & expect that 50% of games will be 7:20/8:10pm.

Approximately half of games during a season will be home games & half away games.

As a club we can only put forth a limited number of requests to the EDJBA for teams to play in only AM or PM timeslots and the EDJBA also cannot guarantee these requests.

Please note: 11.50am is considered a morning & afternoon game by the EDJBA.

Home Venues include; **Bulleen Stadium** (Sheahans Rd), **Templestowe Leisure Centre** (TLC) & **East Doncaster Secondary College** (EDSC)

TRAINING DAY: MONDAY or THURSDAY or FRIDAY

Teams are allocated one 45-minute training session per week on a Monday or Thursday or Friday, between 4:30pm - 9:00pm.

The day and time of training is designed to fit in with the availability of the coach and where possible, players.







TEAM SELECTION / PLAYER PLACEMENT:

Our goal is to ensure that all children can participate in the sport for enjoyment with the potential to prosper in a team at their appropriate level of competition.

In using feedback from team coaches and age group officers we support existing players nominating to continue in their existing team but will take into account the suitably of ALL players across an age group at the time of new season team construction.

Our mission is to ensure that teams 1, 2, 3, and beyond are entered in the EDJBA in order of ability whilst keeping friendship as the foundation for team cohesion.

When managing 1200+ players across all age groups which in several cases have more than 15 teams, it is imperative that players are given every opportunity to progress within our club framework whilst keeping a team balance with bigs and smalls or guards and forwards.

Over time the dynamic and needs of players inevitably change particularly as children enter and progress through the junior championship program and transition from primary to high school which involves forming new friendships so we're fully accommodating that friendship requests will alter over time.

When considering friendship requests all requests need to be reciprocated otherwise there is no guarantee that they can be accommodated.

The more constraints a player has, the harder it is to place them in a team. For example: Training requests or a requirement for AM or PM games etc.

PLEASE keep requests to a minimum to assist our committee in the difficult task of putting teams together.

Late registrations will fit in where and if a spot is available understanding that requests for training, friendship or game day will likely not be accommodated.

PLEASE NOTE: ADJUSTMENTS TO TEAMS CAN BE MADE THROUGHOUT THE GRADING (First 5 rounds) PHASE BY THE SELECTION COMMITTEE DUE TO PLAYER WITHDRAWALS, BALANCING TEAM NUMBERS OR BETTER PLACEMENT OF PLAYERS

(For U17 & ABOVE)

Teams will continue in their current form unless a special request is made by a player and/or coach.

UNIFORMS:

All players must wear the Bulleen reversable JD uniform including both shorts (\$40) & singlet (\$60). These can be ordered online (<u>HERE</u>) or you can await correspondence for uniform shop open days for correct sizing and ordering.

COACHES:

All our coaches are volunteers - generally current or former players, parents, or siblings. The club is always looking for coaches! If interested, please fill out the intention to Coach Registration (link below).





Players joining from other clubs:

- If you have played with another EDJBA club in the past, you will be required to get a clearance / transfer from your previous club before playing with Bulleen.
- It's up to the player to initiate the clearance / transfer when they go to register (if they played at a different EDJBA club in previous seasons). During the online registration form, the system will identify that the player requires a clearance/transfer and will be initiated by the click of a button. It is then up to the source club to confirm the first step, followed by EDJBA and lastly by Bulleen (the destination club). That player will then receive an email notification that the transfer has been completed and can continue their registration.
- The system will not allow a player to register to a new club until all parties have confirmed the clearance / transfer.
- If you've come from a club outside the association e.g. a club that plays in the Coburg, Hawthorn, or Diamond Valley associations, then no clearance is required.
- All previous basketball experience should be noted on the registration form.

REFUND POLICY:

Refunds will be granted on a case-by-case basis at the discretion of the Competitions Manager.

Such circumstances may include:

- Player illness or injury that means the player cannot play for at least six (6) consecutive games. A medical certificate will be required.
- Withdrawals after first 5 rounds (including grading rounds) for medical reasons or any other reason will not be subject to a refund.
- Relocation of a player or the players family more than 20km from the Sheahan's Road Stadium. If a refund is granted <u>A \$50 administration</u> fee will apply for <u>all refunds</u> + any PlayHQ fees & game fees for any games already played will be deducted.

Please note: The BV license fee cannot be refunded by the Club.

Registration of a player is a commitment to playing the entire season to which the fees apply. Withdrawal of a player after registration can impact team structure, venue planning, coaching, and grading. Players who cannot commit to the season should not register or should contact the Competitions Manager to discuss circumstances before registering.

Specifically (and without limitations), refunds are not offered for:

- Change of mind
- Disapproval of the team to which a player is allocated.
- Disapproval of the coach allocated to a player's team
- Disapproval of the team number or grade
- Inability to train at the allocated time or venue.
- Conflicting commitments
- Basketball Victoria or EDJBA sanctions being imposed on the player, parent, or associate.





By Registering the Parent/Guardian and the Child/Player agree to the following

- You have read and understand the REFUND Policy.
- All requests will be accommodated as best possible but are not guaranteed.
- To participate in both trainings and games in a manner that is not disruptive to others
- To respect the use of facilities and equipment provided
- To advise the team manager or coach when you are not able to train or play
- To show respect to all coaches, officials, referees, players and administrators not only from our club and the EDJBA but all clubs and teams we participate against.
- To always abide by the Code of Conduct, stadium entry requirements and any Policies or Procedures set out by the club or EDJBA.

EXPRESS YOUR INTEREST AS AN AGE GROUP OFFICER:

- Act as a point of contact for parent, coach, and manager queries throughout the season.
- Assist the Competitions Manager & Team Selection Committee in coordinating the placement of registered players into appropriate teams each season.
- Liaise with Team Managers & Coaches to receive feedback on grading and advise Competitions Manager of any grading concerns or requests.
- Handle any enquiries from Team Managers and refer to Competitions Manager if required.
- Watch each team twice during the season to evaluate players & Coaches to assist with selection the following season. Preferably once during grading period and once towards end of season.
- Maintain an understanding of all players, coaches, and teams across the age group.

EXPRESS YOUR INTEREST TO BE INVOLVED ON THE TEAM SELECTION COMMITTEE:

- Do you have intimate knowledge of children's abilities in a particular age group?
- We welcome 3 people within each age group for both boys and girls to assist the Competitions Manager and Age Group Officers with ensuring team placement and cohesion is fair and justified.
