



JUNIOR DOMESTIC UNIFORM TRANSITION PLAN

Following the fantastic announcement of our new Junior Domestic Naming Rights Partner **Barry Plant Eastern Group**, the new Junior Domestic uniforms are currently in production, ready for purchase for the Winter 2024 Season.

Currently, our club has variations of three different uniforms being worn on Saturdays within the junior domestic competition which doesn't abide by EDJBA by-laws and none of which have the endorsed Bulleen brand guidelines.

As we look to synergise our club and proudly represent our brand, there will be a clear and concise rollout of the new uniforms over the next 18 months with specific timelines to correct how the previous uniform transition was managed.

We fully understand the current economic climate and have taken this into account with how we execute a clean rollout of the new uniforms which will require a large commitment of time and effort from our Uniform Officer Clare Hoole and staff.

The process we will adopt is as follows:

- a. All players with 2010 & 2015 released uniforms must purchase the new 2024 Barry Plant release uniform by no later than the commencement of the Summer 24/25 Season.
- b. In the event a player (new or existing) joins a team with a majority of the 2020 release then you will purchase the same to ensure consistency in the team's dress code.
- c. In the event a team consists of all new players you will purchase the new 2024 Barry Plant release.
- d. In the event a player (new or existing) wishes to join or upsize uniform where the existing members are wearing the 2010 & 2015 released uniform you will be required to purchase the 2024 Barry Plant release.
- e. Once the Winter 2024 teams are announced all teams have the option to decide whether they, as a team, transition to the new 2024 Barry Plant release uniform immediately. This decision must be unanimous by all members of the team.
- f. All players with a 2020 released uniform must purchase the new Barry Plant 2024 uniform by no later than the commencement of the Summer 25/26 Season.

At such time when the 2024 Barry Plant release is the only uniform accepted for EDJBA competition, we still approve of the 2020 release being used as a training uniform to maximise usage.
